

APERC YOUNG PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMME

An important objective of APERC is to help train energy policy makers in APEC economies. In pursuit of this objective, APERC is establishing a new programme for young professionals in the energy field. This programme will offer unique opportunities for rising energy professionals to broaden their understanding of energy issues by working on current projects with APERC researchers.

1. SELECTION PROCESS

- Open competition based on review of individual applications.
- Recommendation by government, academic institution or energy firm is desirable.
- Preference will be given to candidates with experience in the energy field.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- Each candidate must be a citizen of an APEC member economy between 23 and 35 years of age.
- University degree in economics, public policy, or engineering with some energy related studies.
- Minimum 1 year of research or job experience related to energy
- Competence in spoken and written English
- Competence in software, MS Word, Excel and statistical packages

3. DUTY

- Assist APERC research projects under the guidance of team leaders.

4. SALARY SCALE

- Cash Stipend: 10,000 ~ 13,500 Yen/day after tax.
- Other fringe benefits including Housing and Health Insurance

5. TERMS OF CONTRACT

- Maximum 3 years
- Yearly performance evaluation and review of the contract required
